MAY 2016 ELECTIONS – Bonneville County will be conducting Primary Elections, School District No. 60 Supplemental Levy Election and Central Fire District Election on Tuesday, May 17, 2016. Voters will vote at their regular polling place and must have resided in the county at least 30 days preceding the election.

POLITICAL PARTY RULES – The Constitution Party of Idaho Primary is open to registered members of the Constitution Party, the Idaho Democratic Party Primary is open to any registered voters and the Idaho Republican Primary is open to registered Republicans. In this election, unaffiliated voters may affiliate with a party but **those already affiliated with a party may not change their affiliation** until after the Election Day. (A nonpartisan ballot is included in all ballots.)

EARLY VOTING – Early voting is available in the Elections Office at 825 Shoup Ave. for those who wish to cast their ballots early. The Elections Office will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The last day for early voting will be on Friday, May 13, 2016, until 5:00 p.m.

MAIL-IN ABSENTEES – Any registered voter may request to receive an Official Election Ballot by mail. Requests may be faxed, emailed, or mailed. The mailing address for the Bonneville County Elections is 605 N. Capital Ave, Idaho Falls, ID 83402. A request must be received in the Elections Office by Wednesday, May 11, 2016. Requests require the elector's name, resident address, mailing address for the ballot, signature, and phone number. Ballots must be received by Election Day.

ELECTION DAY HOURS – Polling places in Bonneville County will be open Tuesday, May 17, 2016, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

LAT – The Logic and Accuracy testing consists of checking the accuracy of the ballot tabulating system. Individual candidates, their representative, or other interested parties may participate. Tabulators will be available for any questions. This test will be held on Wednesday, May 11, 2016, at 2 p.m., in the Bonneville County Elections Office at 825 Shoup Ave.

ELECTION RESULTS – Election results will be posted on the Bonneville County website at www.co.bonneville.id.us, as they become available.

CANVASS – The official canvass of votes for Bonneville County is scheduled for Monday, May 23, 2016, at 3:00 p.m. in the Bonneville County Elections Office at 825 Shoup Avenue, Idaho Falls.

ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION – Electors who have moved, changed their names, or have not voted in the last four years must re-register before voting in this election. Those registering on Election Day must show a proof of residency such as a current driver's license, utility bill, fishing license, car registration, or lease agreement. All documents used in providing proof of residence must be accompanied with photo identification.

PHOTO ID REQUIRED – Electors will be required to present a valid photo ID or sign a Personal Identification Affidavit to vote.
