ORDINANCE NO. §

107-77

AN ORDINANCE OF BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO, REQUIRING ANY OWNER, TENANT OR OCCUPANT OF EACH LOT OR PARCEL OF LAND, WITHIN THE COUNTY OF BONNEVILLE, UPON WHICH A BUILDING SHALL HAVE BEEN CONSTRUCTED FOR RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL USE WITHIN 300 FEET, MEASURED ALONG ANY ACCESSABLE ROUTE, OF ANY SANITARY SEWER LINE, TO CONNECT SUCH BUILDING WITH THE SEWAGE COLLECTION SYSTEM OF SAID FACILITY AND TO CEASE TO USE ANY OTHER METHOD FOR THE DISPOSAL OF SANITARY OR INDUSTRIAL SEWAGE; TO MAKE SUCH CONNECTION AT ANY EXTENSION REQUIRED FOR SUCH CONNECTION PURSUANT TO DESIGN AND STANDARDS AS APPROVED BY THE COUNTY OF BONNEVILLE, STATE OF IDAHO; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE FAILURE TO MAKE ANY SUCH CONNECTION; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the discharge of untreated sewage into the underground aquifer from any residential, commercial or industrial use, is deemed a hazard to the health, safety and well being of the residents of Bonneville County; and

WHEREAS, sewage facilities for the collection of sewage waste from residential, commercial and industrial users, have been or will be constructed in certain parts and areas of Bonneville County, Idaho; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interests and for the safety, health and welfare of the residents of Bonneville, County, Idaho that any residential, commercial or industrial users, within close proximity of the sewage collection line shall be required to discharge such sewage into such collection system and to connect thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained by the County Commissioners of the County of Bonneville, Idaho, as follows:

Section 1. That any and all owners, tenant or occupants of each lot or parcel of land within the County of Bonneville upon which a building shall have been constructed for residential, commercial or industrial use and which shall be within 300 feet, measured along any accessible route, of any sanitary sewer line, shall be required to connect such building for a discharge of all sewage waste therefrom into the sewage collection system available and to cease to use any other method for the disposal of sanitary or industrial sewage.

Section 2. That should any extension to any lot or parcel of land as herein stated bring any other lot or parcel of land upon which a building shall have been constructed for residential, commercial or industrial use within 300 feet of such extension then such other lot or parcel shall be required to connect with sewage disposal facilities with such building with such sewage collection system and shall cease to use any other method for the disposal of sanitary or industrial sewage.

TO MAKE SUCH CONNECTION AT ANY EXTENSION REQUIRED FOR SUCH CONNECTION PURSUANT TO DESIGN AND STANDARDS AS APPROVED BY THE COUNTY OF BONNEVILLE, STATE OF IDAHO; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE FAILURE TO MAKE ANY SUCH CONNECTION; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.
