

ORDINANCE NO. 126-82  
BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 109-78 OF THE ORDINANCE OF BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR THE MEMBERSHIP OF SUCH COMMISSION TO CONSIST OF TEN MEMBERS CHOSEN FROM AREAS OF THE COUNTY OF WHICH ONLY THREE MEMBERS MAY BE CHOSEN FROM INCORPORATED CITIES IN THE COUNTY; SPECIFYING THE RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP ON SUCH COMMISSION; AND PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS OF OFFICE AND APPOINTMENT TO SUCH COMMISSION.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO:

Section 1. There is hereby established the Planning and Zoning Commission for the County of Bonneville which may act with the full authority of the County Commissioners, excluding the authority to adopt ordinances.

Section 2. Membership of Commission. Said Commission shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and confirmed by a majority vote of the Board of County commissioners. Said Commission shall consist of ~~(twelve)~~ ten ~~nine-members-with-(eight)-two-thirds-of-the~~ members chosen from the ~~unincorporated~~ various areas of the county and ~~(four)~~ one-third-of-the of which only three members of the Commission may be from incorporated cities in the County. An appointed member of the Commission must have resided in the county for five years prior to his appointment and must remain a resident of the county during his service on the Commission.

Section 3. Terms of Office. ~~The first commission appointed after the adoption of this Ordinance shall consist of three members appointed for a term of three years, three members appointed for a term of two years and three members appointed for a term of one year.~~ be on a three year staggered replacement system. The maximum length of continuous service for an individual member shall be nine years. Service shall be calculated retroactively for all present members but will not take effect until their current appointments expire. Appointments thereafter, except appointments for the unexpired portions of a term, shall be for a term of three years. Appointments shall be made to preserve the ratio of the membership for incorporated and unincorporated areas.

Section 4. Vacancy and Removal of Members. Vacancies occurring otherwise than through the expiration of terms shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment for the remainder of the original term to be filled. Members may be removed for cause by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners or by missing 50% of the meetings of the Board in a calendar year or 3 consecutive regular monthly meetings.

Section 5. Non-voting Ex-Officio Advisors. Non-voting ex-officio advisors may be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners as they deem desirable and necessary.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective November 1, 1982, following the due passage and approval thereof by the Board of County Commissioners, and the publication thereof.
