ORDINANCE NO. "135-83"

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ADMINISTRATIVE,
POSTAGE, AND HANDLING FEES FOR DUTIES
RELATING TO VEHICLE LICENSURE PERFORMED
BY THE BONNEVILLE COUNTY ASSESSOR'S MOTOR
VEHICLE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO:

Pursuant to authority under Idaho Code, Section 49-158 and
31-870, it is hereby ordained:

SECTION 1.0 SHORT TITLE.

1.1 This ordinance shall be known and cited as the
BONNEVILLE COUNTY VEHICLE LICENSE FEE ORDINANCE.

SECTION 2.0 PURPOSE.

2.1 The purpose of this ordinance is to provide funds
sufficient to pay the expense incurred by Bonneville County in its
exercise of duties relating to vehicle licensure.

SECTION 3.0 DEFINITION.

3.1 All words and phrases not specifically defined in this
ordinance will be given their ordinary, commonly understood and
accepted meaning.

SECTION 4.0 ADMINISTRATIVE FEES.

4.1 An administrative fee for vehicle licensure in the
amount of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) shall be collected in
addition to each motor vehicle registration tax or fee amount collected
under the provisions of the Idaho Code, Sections 49-126 and 49-127,
and shall be paid to the county treasurer and be placed in the county
current expense fund.

SECTION 5.0 HANDLING FEE.

5.1 A handling fee up to the amount of one dollar (\$1.00)
shall be collected whenever registration services are performed by
the Bonneville County Assessor's Office, Motor Vehicle Department.

SECTION 6.0 CODE PRIORITY.

6.1 Requirements specifically addressed by more than one (1) code will be in accordance with the most restrictive code adopted herein.

SECTION 7.0 SEVERABILITY.

7.1 If any portion of this ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstances shall be held invalid, the remaining portion shall remain in full force and effect.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO
BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO
ORDINANCE NO. 135-83

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Commissioners of Bonneville County, Idaho, that certain ordinance known as Ordinance No. 135-83, Bonneville County, Idaho, an ordinance relating to motor vehicle licensure, is hereby amended as Section 49-158 of the Idaho Code has been repealed relating to additional fees for motor vehicle licensure and Sections 31-870 and 63-2201A of the Idaho Code have been amended, first amendment to County Ordinance No. 135-83 to include a change in Section 4.0 Administrative Fees to read:

Section 4.0 ADMINISTRATIVE FEES.

4.1 An administrative fee for vehicle licensure shall be established by resolution of the Bonneville County Board of Commissioners providing that the fee collected shall be reasonably related to, but shall not exceed, the actual cost of the service being rendered; shall be collected in addition to each motor vehicle registration tax or fee amount collected under the provisions of the Idaho Code, Sections 49-126, 49-127, and 49-159; and shall be paid to the county treasurer and be placed in the county current expense fund.

HEREBY, first amendment is to delete "49-158 and" in the second paragraph following "Pursuant to authority under Idaho Code,"; to delete part of the second line of 4.1 "in the amount of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) in Section 4.0 Administrative Fees and read as above; and to delete all of Section 5.0 Handling Fee.

All other provisions of said ordinance known as Ordinance No. 135-83 relating to motor vehicle licensure shall remain and hereby do remain in full force and effect. The effective date of this Amendment shall be the first day of July, 1988, and the day adopted by the Board of County Commissioners being the 20 day of June, 1988.


R E S O L U T I O N


WHEREAS, Bonneville County Ordinance No. 135-83 has been amended to allow for the County Commissioners to establish, by resolution, an administrative fee for motor vehicle licensures pursuant to Idaho Code 31-870, which allows for the establishment of fees to provide services to county residents, reasonably related to the costs of providing the services being rendered, but not exceeding the costs of actual services, and


WHEREAS, the amount of two dollars (\$2.00) per motor vehicle licensure transaction has been determined to be a reasonable fee, but not exceeding the cost of the service rendered,


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Bonneville County Board of Commissioners that the amount of two dollars (\$2.00) be established as an administrative fee for each motor vehicle licensure transaction in Bonneville County, except recreation vehicles, transfers, duplicate registration, duplicate plates and stickers, and titles.
