

ORDINANCE NO. 150-89

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT POSSESSION OF A FIREARM, OTHER DANGEROUS WEAPON, EXPLOSIVE OR INCENDIARY DEVICE WITHIN A BONNEVILLE COUNTY PUBLIC BUILDING CONSTITUTES COMMISSION OF A MISDEMEANOR, PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL, DISTRICT COURT MARSHALS AND INDIVIDUALS WHO POSSESS A VALID PERMIT TO CARRY A CONCEALED WEAPON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BONNEVILLE COUNTY:

Pursuant to authority under Article XII, Section 2 of the Constitution of the State of Idaho and the requirements of Chapter 41 of Title 39, Idaho Code, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

Section 1.0 SHORT TITLE.

Section 1.1. This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the Bonneville County Firearms and Dangerous Weapons Ordinance.

Section 2.0 Purpose.

Section 2.1 The purpose of this Ordinance is to prohibit the possession of a firearm, other dangerous weapon, explosive or incendiary device in any public building, owned or operated by Bonneville County "wherein any elected official, court of the State of Idaho or any judicial officer is housed or has offices," and making such possession a misdemeanor violation, except in those circumstances where the individual carrying or possessing the firearm, other dangerous weapon, explosive or incendiary device is a law enforcement official of the State of Idaho or a political subdivision thereof, a District Court Marshall, or an individual possessing a valid permit to carry a concealed weapon.

Section 3.0 Definitions.

Section 3.1 All words and phrases used in this Ordinance shall be given their ordinary, commonly understood and accepted meaning.

Section 4.0 Exceptions.

Section 4.1 This Ordinance does not apply to law enforcement officials of the State of Idaho, or a political

subdivision thereof, to Marshals of the Seventh Judicial District, or to an individual who possesses a valid permit to carry a concealed weapon, issued by Bonneville County Sheriff.

Section 5.0 Weapon Possession.

Section 5.1 It shall be unlawful for any person to have in his possession a firearm, other dangerous weapon, explosive or incendiary device whether loaded or unloaded, while said person is within any public building, owned and operated by Bonneville County "wherein any elected official, court of the State of Idaho or any judicial officer is housed or has offices." Any person convicted of a violation of this prohibition shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment.


Section 6.0 Publication and Effective Date.


That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the County Commissioners of the County of Bonneville and its due publication as required by law.


