

SHERIFF'S RESERVE ORDINANCE #2

AN ORDINANCE OF BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO, RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A BONNEVILLE COUNTY SHERIFF'S RESERVE CREATING SUCH RESERVE; MAKING IT UNLAWFUL AND A PETTY MISDEMEANOR TO OBSTRUCT, DELAY, OR RESIST ANY MEMBER OF THE SHERIFF'S RESERVE IN THE DISCHARGE OF THEIR DUTIES. ESTABLISHING RULES, REGULATIONS, AND OPERATING POLICY OF THE SHERIFF'S RESERVE; DESIGNATING MEMBERS OF THE SHERIFF'S RESERVE AS PEACE OFFICERS; MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO IMPERSONATE MEMBERS OF THE SHERIFF'S RESERVE; PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION AND INSURANCE OF MEMBERS OF THE SHERIFF'S RESERVE; PROVIDING FOR THE RESIGNATION AND DISMISSAL OF MEMBERS OF THE SHERIFF'S RESERVE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BONNEVILLE COUNTY, IDAHO, as follows, to-wit:

Section 1: Definitions. Whenever in this ordinance the following terms are used, they shall have the meaning ascribed to them in this section, unless otherwise apparent from the context.

(a) "County Commissioners" shall mean the Board of County Commissioners of Bonneville County, Idaho.

(b) "Sheriff" shall mean the Sheriff of Bonneville County, Idaho.

(c) "Reserve" shall mean the Bonneville County Sheriff's Reserve.

(d) "Member" shall mean member of the Bonneville County Sheriff's Reserve.

(e) "County" shall mean Bonneville County, Idaho.

Section 2. Sheriff's Reserve Created.-- The Bonneville County Sheriff's Reserve is hereby created. Said Reserve shall consist of as many members as may be determined by the Sheriff.

Section 3. Unlawful to Interfere.--Members shall perform only such duties and services as may be directed by the Sheriff. It shall be unlawful and a petty misdemeanor for any person to willfully resist, delay, interfere with, or obstruct any member in the discharge, or in the attempt to discharge, any of his duties of office.

Section 4. Rules, Regulations and Operating Policy.

Rules, regulations and operating policy, governing the operation of the reserve, shall be established by the Sheriff and members shall comply with such policy.

Section 5. Members are Peace Officers.--In the enforcement of the laws of Bonneville County and the State of Idaho and in the performance of other such duties as may be designated by the Sheriff, all duly authorized members shall be deemed to have all the powers of a peace officer during the hours such member is assigned to duty.

Section 6. Unlawful to Impersonate.-- It shall be unlawful for any person to falsely impersonate or represent himself to be a member, or to wear, use, display, or possess a badge or identification card of the reserve unless he or she is a member of the reserve. No member shall wear his uniform or display his badge except at those times and in the manner prescribed by the Sheriff.

Section 7. Compensation and Insurance

Members shall receive compensation from the county for any service rendered in such amounts as may be prescribed by the County Commissioners, but in no event shall such compensation exceed the amount which would be paid to a first year deputy sheriff of the Bonneville County Sheriff's Department for similar service.

In the event of injury or death of a member while he is discharging duties assigned to him by the Sheriff, said member or his beneficiaries shall be entitled to benefits as may be provided in a special risk insurance policy to be maintained and paid for by the county.

Vehicle operation and false arrest and detention coverage will be provided in the general liability insurance policy of Bonneville County the same as would be provided for the Sheriff or any deputy sheriff of Bonneville County.

Section 8. Resignation and Dismissal.

Each member of the reserve shall have the right to resign from said reserve at any time. The Sheriff may dismiss a member at any time without hearing.
